1. The Daniel Boone High School Marine Corps JROTC will proudly host its 24th annual Invitational Drill Meet on **Saturday, 16 January 2021**.
2. This comprehensive meet features **Armed and Unarmed Squad and Platoon** competition, **1st Year Cadet Squad** drill, **Color Guard**, and **Individual / Dual Exhibition** events. The meet also offers the “**Elite Division**” to give smaller and less experienced units an opportunity to compete for awards in color guard and squad / element drill.
3. We are particularly proud of the caliber of our judging cadre who are Drill Instructors, Drill Sergeants, or have an extensive background in drill and ceremony. Judges will be fielded from each of the Armed Forces Regular and Reserve establishments. **Teams will be judged by their respective service manuals** (i.e., FM 3-21.5, MCO P5060.20, AFMAN 36-2203).

Twenty-eight schools from a six state region registered for last year’s meet. **Daniel Boone’s team does NOT compete in the Meet.** Daniel Boone High School is located 4 miles from the I-81/I-26 intersection in the Johnson City, Tennessee area. Interest in this meet is high, so if you wish to enter your team in this exceptional, all services, **indoor competition** complete and mail/email/fax the enclosed form and your payment. **No team will be reserved a place until a completed application and payment are received. The deadline to enter is Friday, 11 December 2020.**

We make changes every year to improve the quality of the meet.
