VIRTUAL AND POSTAL MATCH

1. The Daniel Boone High School MCJROTC cordially invites your unit to compete in our 2024-2025 Musket & Ball Air Rifle Virtual/Postal Match. This competition is open to Sporter class shooters in your program or club. Shooting teams will be able to compete in one of two categories: Sporter "Veteran" and Sporter "Boot".
2. Participants will shoot as four (4) member teams or as individual shooters. **No shooter may be a member of more than one team.**
3. If your unit does not participate in a marksmanship program or you wish to be removed from our mailing list, please assist us in managing our mailing list by simply indicating your selection on the entry form and returning it, or send an email.
4. Please feel free to pass along this invitation to any other school within your area who you believe may wish to participate in our match.
5. The following information is furnished regarding the postal match.

ENTRY: Entry fee is \$50 for the first team; see entry form for all subsequent teams. The entry fee for individual shooters who are not part of a team is \$15 each. Units may enter as many teams and individuals as they wish. The non-refundable entry fee will enter all members of the team into the competition for their category. **Entry forms and fees are due NLT 15 December 2024** in order to allow time to "child" units to the "parent" match. Checks should be made payable to Daniel Boone High School MCJROTC.

FIRING PERIOD: Match shooting may occur any time between **5 September 2024 and 12 January 2025**. All targets and Unit Firing Reports must be **postmarked no later than midnight 12 January 2025**. Failure to return targets by the date indicated may result in disqualification.

TEAMS: Teams will consist of four (4) Cadets, any gender, enrolled in the school's JROTC program or shooting club. No individual may compete on more than one team. There are two team categories: Sporter Veteran, and Sporter Boot. **A team is considered a "Veteran" team if one of its members is an experienced shooter with formal marksmanship training prior to this year. A "Boot" team is completely comprised of first year inexperienced shooters. A "Boot" shooter on Veteran teams (if identified) will also compete in the "Boot" individual**

category. Sporter shooters must use non-precision air rifles and equipment as classified by the 2022-2024 National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules for Sporter competition.

COURSES OF FIRES/RULES: Firing will take place on a standard 10-meter (33 Feet) course measured from firing line to target. The course of fire will consist of 10 shots in each of the Kneeling, Prone, and Standing positions. Only one 10-bulls-eye target will be used for each position. Unlimited practice shots (Sighting Shots) are allowed during the sighting stages, but they must stay inside the practice oval. Any shot outside the practice oval will count as a shot on the target. The match and all conditions will be governed by the 2022-2024 National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules.

TARGETS: The match will be computer scored; therefore, only ORION 10 Meter Air Rifle Targets or Orion/Scopos compatible ETSs are to be use for this match.

There will be three methods of competing in the match; (1) virtually through Orion, (2) virtually with electronic targets compatible with Scopos, or (3) traditional mail-in utilizing Orion targets.

1. For those units/clubs that prefer the virtual option, the unit name (**as it appears in Orion/Scopos**) **AND Orion/Scopos account number is required*** in order to “child” your team(s) to the “parent” match. This information must be entered on the registration form. For this option, once your team(s) is “childed” to the match, you will simply download the match, shoot the match, score your targets through Orion, and finalize the scores on the “match results” page.

2. For those units/clubs that prefer the virtual option utilizing electronic targets, the unit name (**as it appears in Orion/Scopos**) **AND Orion/Scopos account number is required** in order to “child” your team(s) to the “parent match. You are also responsible for ensuring your ETS is compatible with Scopos scoring platform. For this option, once your team(s) is “childed” to the match, you will simply download the match, shoot the match, finalize the scores on the “match results” page. Again, all information must be entered on the registration form.

3. For those units/clubs that choose the traditional mail-in option, teams will provide their own Orion targets. If your program does not have Orion targets, send an e-mail as soon as possible with the number of targets needed and a correct mailing address and we will mail Orion targets to you. There will be an additional charge for postage and handling for targets sent. See the entry form for details.

***Note: Your Orion account number is usually a 4 or 5-digit alphanumeric number specific to your team/club. This information is only used to differentiate one “Central High School” from another.**

TARGET IDENTIFICATION: Target stickers are not required but are highly encouraged. If target stickers are not used, each target must be legibly labeled on the back top left corner with the following information: School Name, Team Designation (i.e. Team A), Shooter Name, Category Sporter (Veteran/Boot), and Position Fired (Prone/Standing/Kneeling). **The attached**

Unit Firing Report must be legibly completed and returned with the targets. This will ensure the shooter's name and category is correctly entered in the database.

SCORING: Scoring will be computed by the Orion Scoring System. Participating Teams may only sight score their own targets before sending them to Daniel Boone High School. Any effort to “plug” a shot may result in disqualification as the Orion System will not recognize a “plugged” shot. Team member scores will be added for team aggregate score.

TIED SCORES: The scores will be broken in accordance with the National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules for breaking ties.

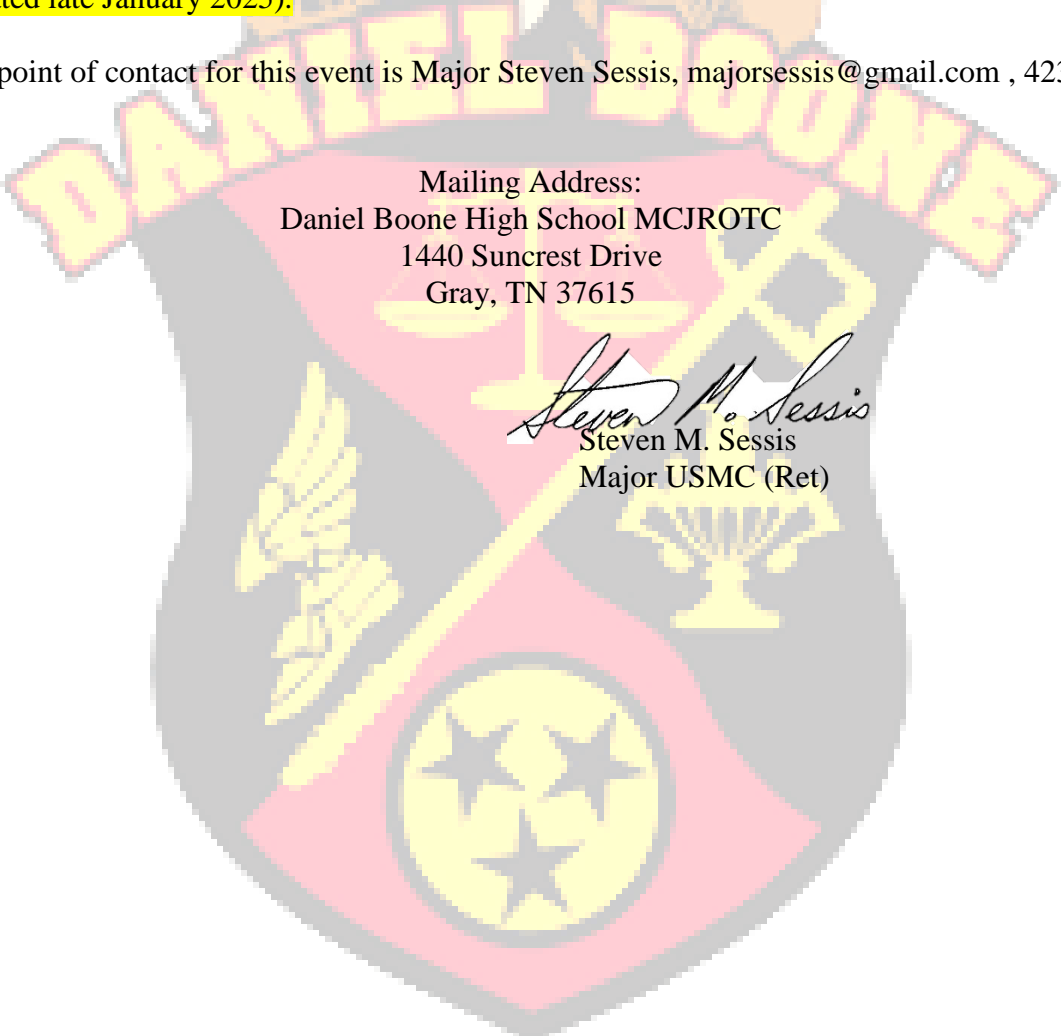
AWARDS: Awards will be presented in Veteran and Boot categories. Team trophies will be presented for the highest overall team scores, 1st through 3rd place. Individual medals will be presented for 1st through 3rd place highest overall individual aggregate score, and top 3 scores in the Prone, Standing, and Kneeling positions. Individual medallions will be presented to the team member with the highest overall aggregate score within his/her team.

RESULTS: Match results and awards will be mailed as soon as scoring tabulation is complete (estimated late January 2025).

General Instructions

Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Form 1099-INT (interest earned or paid)
- Form 1099-DIV (dividends, including those from stocks or mutual funds)
- Form 1099-MISC (various types of income, prizes, awards, or gross proceeds)
- Form 1099-B (stock or mutual fund sales and certain other transactions by brokers)
- Form 1099-S (proceeds from real estate transactions)
- Form 1099-K (merchant card and third party network transactions)
- Form 1098 (home mortgage interest), 1098-E (student loan interest), 1098-T (tuition)
- Form 1099-C (cancelled debt)
- Form 1099-A (acquisition or abandonment of secured property)

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN.

If you do not return Form W-9 to the requester with a TIN, you might be subject to backup withholding. See *What is backup withholding*, later.
